Contact Access Aurora (303.326.8200) to report ice buildups on streets. They will put your request in the queue for the City Streets Dept. to come and clear your street.

Snow Shoveling

Within 24 hours after a snowfall ends, snow must be removed from ALL city sidewalks adjacent to your property, including snow on sidewalks outside rear and side fences. The fine for single family homes is \$25/day for the first two days, and then the city will charge the homeowner for a city contractor to remove the snow.

Welcome to 2024! With the coming of the new year, we have a new PAR officer, Ofc. Jenkins, who can be reached directly at 303.627.3177. In addition, the Aurora police department will have a new interim deputy police chief, Heather Morris as of April 3rd. One of her stated priorities is to increase the number of officers to the maximum allowed and to focus on retention of the police force.


