It Takes a Village...

Our neighborhood is important to all of us and we're all invested in this community. But the HOA currently needs more volunteers. After several

recent retirements, the board is in a transitional phase with a lot of new members who have thankfully stepped up to serve our community, but we still have several open positions that need filled. The following open volunteer positions include you as a member of the HOA board:

Secretary: Responsibilities include coordinating communication, taking meeting notes, and crafting agendas for the next meeting.

Treasurer: Responsibilities include taking payments for dues and newsletter ads, paying bills, and tracking expenses.

Neighborhood Watch Co-Chair: Responsibilities include working with our PAR officer and neighbors on tracking crime or any suspicious activity in the neighborhood and communicating that with the Board.

In addition to voluntary HOA Board positions, we are also in need of some new block coordinators. Block Coordinators primary responsibility is newsletter distribution—our main communication device for neighborhood events and updates—and the following areas need volunteers:

Area 8N: Covering 13 homes. Area 18: Covering 30 homes.

Ideally, we'd prefer those who live in those areas of the neighborhood to volunteer as Block Coordinators as it is a way to help with community engagement, but anyone willing to assist with covering those areas will not be turned down for the meanwhile. We also are now missing a volunteer to distribute news to the mailbox flyers as well. Many of us serving on the new Board are parents with young and school-age kids, so we have a lot of family schedules we're maintaining on top of trying to do our very best to serve the neighborhood. We really appreciate any help that you can offer if you're able to lend us a hand in serving the neighborhood!

Also, major thanks to Kay Ague who has stepped up as a Block Coordinator for Area 26! Your help there is greatly appreciated!

The new board would also like to thank those who have served on the board for our neighborhood for several years! Their decades of contributions to the neighborhood has been beyond tremendous.

Going Digital

Due to increasing open spots and current open spots for Block Coordinator volunteers, as well as cost concerns and other issues with our meeting space situation, the Board will be looking to make a gradual transition to creating a stronger digital presence as we move forward.

What does that mean for you? First and foremost, it means a move toward more up to date information for everyone. Along with our quarterly meetings at Sagebrush Elementary, we are aiming to have all meetings available on the Zoom platform. Some scheduling issues that have come up with our current meeting space have also led us to explore this further as our primary option. Our hope is that while we test it out this year that we may also get more community engagement in our HOA meetings, which we value highly. City News

At the February 24 Ward V Town Meeting hosted by Woodgate's City Council Representative, Angela Lawson, several free programs were described which could possibly benefit our neighborhood. The Aurora Fire Department can provide free, 10-year smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors, as well as install them, if you contact the Fire Dept at 303-326-8999. The Director of Public Works, Cindy Colip, said that we can request the stop signs with the blinking lights on the rims, speed cushions (lighter speed bumps such as the ones on S. Heather Gardens Way), and other traffic calming changes. Go to <u>auroragov.org/trafficcalming</u> to get a description of the program and a request form. Cindy also mentioned that we should report potholes via Access Aurora to get the quickest response.

Neighborhood Watch Update

Welcome to the start of the warmer months. With the extended daylight hours, we ask that you remain vigilant to your surroundings and maintain situational awareness in the evenings. The last few months have resulted in one incident of larcenry from a yard, one incident of burglary from a vehicle, and vandalism to a vehicle, and one report of a stolen vehicle.

If you experience a crime, please report it both to the police so that they can allocate appropriate resources, and also to the neighborhood watch so we can better track trends in the neighborhood and try to identify ways to reduce future occurrences.
